TYPICAL INSTALLATION

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- 1. Remove the old timing cover from the vehicle and ensure all gasket surfaces are cleaned.
- **2.** Before final assembly, it is recommended to check clearance from the oil pump/timing chain assembly (will fit single and most double roller timing chains).
- **3.** Install the o-ring into the groove of the bottom half of the timing cover. Some oring cord may be left over and will need to be trimmed accordingly. You may also apply a gasket sealer as extra precaution.
- **4.** Assemble the 2-piece cover together with a new timing cover gasket and fasten (but not tighten) the supplied M8 screws.
- **5.** Before torquing the timing cover down, it is recommended to use one of our timing cover alignment tools to aid in correct crankshaft alignment (PFEGK-LSTC1 or PFEGK-LSTC2).
- **6.** Torque each stainless steel screw down to a total of 20 Nm in two steps (10 Nm and then 20 Nm). Also fasten the oil pan bolts.
- 7. Install a timing cover seal if not already installed on the cover.
